WEEKEND WORK: Saturday Nov. 21th. In an effort to move the UPB project forward we will be doing NIGHT work this weekend. Our goal is to keep the public is aware of possible delays, detours, lane closures & potential noise. Having advance notice of these events will allow local residents & business to prepare accordingly. Pedestrian detours will be routed for the safety of the public & workers. Clear signage will be in place directing both foot & vehicular traffic/detours. Our goal is to keep you informed of activity on a regular basis with frequent notices.

Vehicular & pedestrian traffic will be safely routed around the construction zone & one lane will remain open in both directions at all times. Temporary lane closures will be on Universal Hollywood Drive; Lankershim Blvd. & Campo de Cahuenga. Traffic control will be performed by Griffith Company or a subcontractor in accordance with the WATCH manual & approved traffic handling plans. *Access to Universal Studios and City Walk will be maintained. Detours will be clearly marked.*

Large trucks/cranes, noise from installation, pedestrian rerouting, night lane closures, re-routing of traffic access to Universal area, temporary off ramp closure.

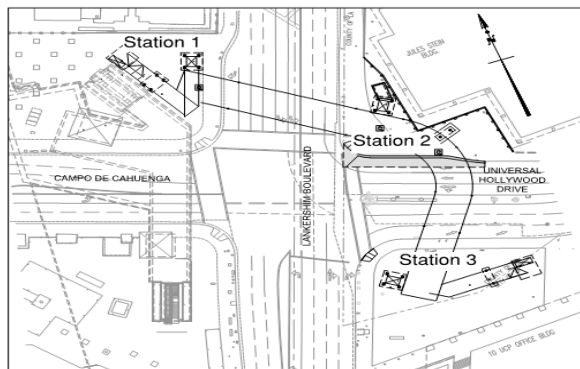
Vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be safely routed around the construction zone Full access to Universal Studios and City Walk will be maintained with re-routing clearly marked.
