REQUIREMENTS:

- Attend an interview session
- Complete a live scan
- Attend a 9-week 62-hour CRT Training Academy
- Respond to critical incidents providing immediate on-scene crisis intervention
- Commit to 1 year of volunteering and 36 on-call hours per month
